



Dockside Pavilion Darling Harbour Enters Final Phase of Construction

Sydney Hospitality company, Dockside Group's much-anticipated new floating venue - Dockside Pavilion Darling Harbour - is now in its final weeks of construction and on target to open at the end of this month.

Over the weekend, the 90 metre-long structure was floated around to Darling Harbour in five large sections from Glebe Island. During the relocation, the Pyrmont Bridge was opened, allowing the nine metre high structure to gain access into Cockle Bay.

Due to its magnitude, the majority of construction took place at Glebe Island, with the final stage of assembly happening in situ, including the installation of the Pavilion's fabric skin.

The Pavilion structure was designed by Warwick Bell from Fabric Structure Systems in Auckland, who famously created The Cloud for the New Zealand Rugby World Cup. The venue comprising state-of-the-art fabrics and design will be the first of its kind in Australia.

The new event venue will be open for business in late July in conjunction with the Sydney International Boat Show between July 31 and August 4.

The Dockside Pavilion is a temporary venue owned and operated by Dockside Group and will remain in Darling Harbour until December 2016. For more information about Dockside Group visit www.docksidegroup.com.au
